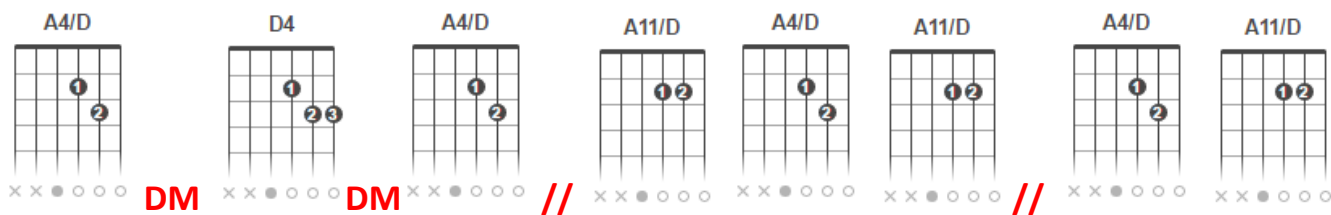

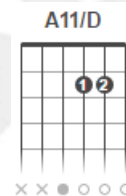

 I SEE THE GIRLS WALK BY DRESSED IN THEIR SUMMER CLOTHES

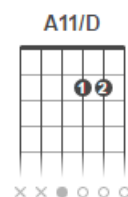

 I SEE PEOPLE TURN THEIR HEADS AND QUICKLY LOOK AWAY



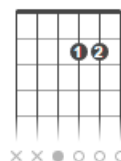

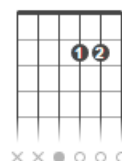

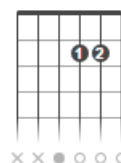
